




NOAM CHOMSKY

American philosopher, historian and political activist.



Known as "the father of modern linguistics", Professor Chomsky is a prominent academic in analytic philosophy and a founder of the field of cognitive science. He is the author of more than 100 books on topics including linguistics, war, politics and mass media. Recent research in three different citation indices indicate that Professor Chomsky is one of the most cited individuals in works published in the past 20 years. It appears one cannot write a paper without citing Noam Chomsky.

With plenty of experience battling neglect and abuse to wild animals, she featured in the docuseries having testified at Joe Exotic's trial and rescued nearly 50 animals from his custody.

Diego Soto-Miranda is a London commercial barrister and double LSE graduate. He was born with spinal muscular atrophy which keeps him immobile from the neck down. Soto-Miranda has previously spoken about the shock he has seen in his courtroom opponents when they have seen him wheelchair bound opposing them. His story is one of challenges, determination and success.



GINA MILLER

Guyanese-British businesswoman,
campaigner and activist.

Co-Founder of SCM Direct & Founder of Centrum Campaign Limited. She has twice led legal challenges against the government and won. Her first victory came in 2017, when the Supreme Court ruled in favour of giving MP's a say over triggering Article 50 to take the UK out of the EU. Her second came in September 2019, when the Supreme Court ruled that PM Boris Johnson's decision to suspend Parliament was unlawful.



GETTING INVOLVED

Naturally, involvement in the Union goes beyond merely attending our events. While some committeees will be more active than others following current lockdown restrictions, there is no harm in considering a future role in our society. Whether it involves a position as one of our elected officers or as a regular member in our many committeees, there is a role for everyone who wants to drive the Union forward.

President's Committee

Helps the President-Elect to prepare for their upcoming term, by researching potential speakers for addresses, debates and forums, and assisting them in the drafting of invitations.

Secretary's Committee

Consists of representatives from the University's colleges, who are elected in order to gather members' feedback, and distribute Union publicity to all members.

Debates Committee

Organises the debating workshops and internal competitions, helping to run three of the largest debating competitions in the UK: the IV, the Schools' Competition and the Open.

House Committee

Responsible for taking care of the logistical operations that accompany each of our events.

Rules Committee

Assist the Returning Officer in running free and fair elections to all Union positions, by scrutinising procedures. They also ensure that the Union's constitution is constantly up to date and relevant.

Social Committee

Working with the Social Secretary, this committee helps organise the Union's social events, and is perfect for anyone interested in getting involved with the creative side of the Union.

Sponsorship Committee

In tandem with the Sponsorship Secretary, this committee encourages outside bodies (local and national companies) to support the Union's events.

Bar Committee

Anyone can join 24s' Bar Committee to air your views and have your say on how the best bar in Durham is run.

Student DEBATING

For those who would like to try debating, the Durham Union Society also has an excellent competitive squad. We hold regular training sessions at novice, intermediate, and advanced level and, nearly every week, we send students across the country to compete on behalf of Durham. We also compete at the World and European Debating Championships.

This year, the Union's competitive debate squads have proven themselves on the UK and international circuits, winning several competitions and reaching the finals of others. Our A team broke at the World Universities Debating Championship in Thailand at the beginning of the year. Last term we also hosted the first Durham LGBT+ Open, which was a great success.


